Subject: Sunshine Law Request – Audit Trail and Notification Records for **Case 24CR-AC00262**

Dear OSCA Help Desk,

Pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law (RSMo Chapter 610), I am requesting public records related to automated notifications and system access logs associated with **Case No. 24CR-AC00262**, *Christopher M. Larsen v. Town of Carrollton, Missouri*. I am requesting these records as a part of an ongoing matter currently under consideration by the Commission on Retirement, Removal and Discipline (CRRD).

I enrolled through Case.net to receive automated email notifications regarding filings, docket entries, and other updates for this case. However, the only email I received from the system was dated **January 17, 2024**, referencing my **Opposition to Motion for Dismissal**. I received no further notifications after that date regarding any developments in the case.

To be clear: **I did not deactivate notifications**. I was relying on them, especially during that time, as I had just lost my mother and was navigating both legal and personal trauma. It was my expectation that Case.net would keep me informed, and I made no changes to opt out of updates.

I raised the issue with the **Circuit Clerk's Office**, asking whether someone inside that courthouse building might have changed my notification preferences for this case. I was told **no**, that no one in that building had access to make such a change. I followed up with a question about whether a **global setting** might have been changed that disabled case notifications for this case as a whole. I was again told **no** — that such a change could not be made at the local courthouse level.

Accordingly, I respectfully request the following:

1. **Any and all records of email notifications** or automated messages related to Case No. 24CR-AC00262 that were scheduled, generated, or sent by the Case.net system, including the intended recipient address, timestamp, and subject line.
2. **An audit trail of notification status changes** specific to my Case.net account for this case - and where an audit trail exists for changes to "global settings" relating to case notifications that might have been changed internally, including:
 - The **date and time** notification preferences were enabled or disabled;

- The **IP address and user agent string** of the device used to perform any such action;
 - The **user ID or system account** that made the changes (if applicable).
3. Any information as to whether notifications for this case may have been **globally disabled** or suppressed through a system-level setting or administrative override.

This issue has caused substantial confusion and controversy, and resolution is essential for both my ongoing matter and my trust in the integrity of the electronic court systems.

Please provide the requested records electronically if possible. If any part of this request is denied, kindly provide the specific statutory exemption being applied and a detailed explanation.

Thank you for your assistance and transparency in this important matter. I look forward to your response.
