Re: Formal Request Regarding Retaliatory Code Enforcement Actions


Dear Mr. Larsen:

The Town of Carrollton is in receipt of your "Formal Request Regarding Retaliatory Code Enforcement Actions, dated, Wednesday, December 11, 2024 via email and by certified mail at City Hall on Friday, December 13, 2024 entitled, "Formal Request Regarding Retaliatory Code Enforcement Actions". The Town of Carrollton assumes that your request is a request for information under the Missouri Sunshine Law which can be found in Chapter 610 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri.

The Town is obligated to disclose any "public record" as defined in RSMo. 610.10(6). The Town has determined that the items requested should not be furnished without charge or at a reduced charge because there is no basis for finding that such waiver or reduction is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the public government.

You requested, "Compaints Received, Nature Of Complaints and Internal Communications". There are no copies of complaints received. It was reported, there was a citizen that came to City Hall and made a verbal complaint but wished to remain anonymous. There are no written internal communications to produce regarding this matter. Any communications with attorneys are protected by attorney client privelege. Nature of Complaints is not a proper request for documents therefore no documentation will be produced.
