**Subject:** Response to Code Enforcement Records Request Explanation

Dear Dana,

I am writing in response to the Town's explanation regarding the alleged "anonymous complaint" about the fencing material on my property. The explanation is remarkable, particularly given its vague description and the uncanny timing of the complaint. It seems almost miraculous that such an event would coincide so precisely with other interactions I have had with the Town.

### **Request for Records Related to Enforcement Actions**

In light of this, I am formally requesting a record of all enforcement actions taken by the Town of Carrollton regarding fencing materials similar to those seen on my property. Specifically, this request includes:

- All enforcement actions related to fencing materials within the past two years.
- Any documentation or correspondence associated with these enforcement actions, including records of complaints, investigations, or citations.

### **Concern Regarding Anonymity Standards**

I also find it deeply concerning and inconsistent that the Town insists on protecting the identity of the individual who allegedly complained about the fencing materials on my property, yet does not afford me the same right to anonymity when I place a 911 call for service. The circumstances of my 911 call left me reasonably concerned about potential retaliation, a fear that any objective and reasonable person would recognize as valid. This disparity in treatment raises serious questions about fairness and the Town's approach to handling sensitive matters.

For the same non-commercial purposes as described above, in addition to the enforcement records I am requesting herein, I also want to review whatever documents that Town might have relating to its official policy as it relates to anonymity of complainants for both code enforcement matters, and for matters relating to 911 calls for service.

I trust the Town will provide a timely and thorough response to this request, and I look forward to reviewing the records related to this issue.
